To the Board,

At 6.30 pm on Friday evening of the 23 of October I received a phone call from the General Manager stating that John Twomey, Alex Jones and Chris Drake had entered the office just prior to closing stating their authority to be there as board members and under duress demanded access and passwords to the HGFA systems from the sole office staff in attendance. As it was now after hours the staff member left these three members completely unattended and with full access. They then called the General Manager and demanded that they be given the password for the security system to lock up.

I immediately called and left a message on Rob Woodward's mobile as he was on transit to Melbourne.

At no time was the board and or executive officers including the General Manager given any prior warning or notice. The board has not or would not give authority to any member to act in this manner to obtain confidential passwords.

The seriousness of this behaviour and breeches of security is of the highest level.

- No member has access to the office or its contents unless prior appointments have been made within reasonable time frames and within normal office hours.
- No member has access to information unless provided through the General Manager or Office Staff.
- No member (including board members) should have access to passwords for the system or office security.
- John Twomey and Alex Jones used their authority as board members without the approval of the majority of the board.
- These members were noted to have USB sticks and as such no one will ever know what confidential content has been removed and or added to the HGFA systems.
- The entire contents of the HGFA are now in the hands of three (or more) members without support or approval of the board or the members of the HGFA.
- Chris Drake has a profession in IT and software development specialising in tracking and spyware and as such we will have no idea what has been removed and or tampered with on the HGFA computer systems and as such must now be considered as a major security risk to all our private information.
- No induction has been made to any of these members of the HGFA systems and as such any tampering can seriously alter and or destroy these resources, systems, applications and files.

The three members of the board Peter Dower, Tracey Hayes (who gave us her power of authority prior to her trip) and Peter Wennersten now raise a motion for this morning's AGM that Alex Jones and John Twomey be immediately suspended from the board and that all materials removed from the offices be returned immediately and without delay. Further more that they have no voting privileges at the AGM or subsequent committee meeting. #

We also raise a motion that if by majority the remanning board members of Rob Woodward, Raef Mackay and Ray Firth had prior knowledge and or gave approval for this action that they also be stood down for failing to inform the entire executive of their intentions and as such reaching a legitimate consensus. "

A final motion is placed that as members who have been entrusted and voted by its members to represent them and not to bring our organisation into disrepute that John Twomey, Alex Jones and Chris Drake not be accepted onto the 2010 - 2012 HGFA board. "

These motions are to be raised and voted by the members present.
